## WHAT TO BRING

- BYO LUNCH We will provide some snacks, fruit, water and soft drink onboard
- Water bottle
- A good hat that won't blow off in the wind
- Sunglasses and sunscreen
- Long sleeved sun shirt(s) and/or collared tops for sun protection
- Wet-weather or spray jacket
- A change of clothes in case you get wet
- Outside of high summer, a warm jumper and long pants as it can get cold on the water
- White-soled trainers or deck shoes no hard black soles please, as they mark the deck. A spare pair of shoes is a good idea in case others get wet. No thongs or sandals.
- A soft bag for packing your belongings

## WHERE AND WHEN TO MEET?

- Boat locations can vary within Manly Boat Harbour. Most frequently, the departure point is from our office at East Coast Marina. Your final meeting point confirmation will come a couple of days prior to your sail date once student allocation is finalised. Please keep a look out for this important reminder email, as it will also include further parking instructions.
- East Coast Marina car park is a member-only access zone on weekends. Keep this in mind when planning your journey.
- Students meet the instructor and proceed as a group to the training yacht promptly at **9am**. Please aim to arrive at least 15 minutes early, allowing extra time for parking as Manly is a busy place on weekends.
- You will return to the marina around **4pm**, with additional time to remove belongings from the yacht.
- If you prefer to catch the train to Manly Station, it is a 1km downhill walk to East Coast Marina.
